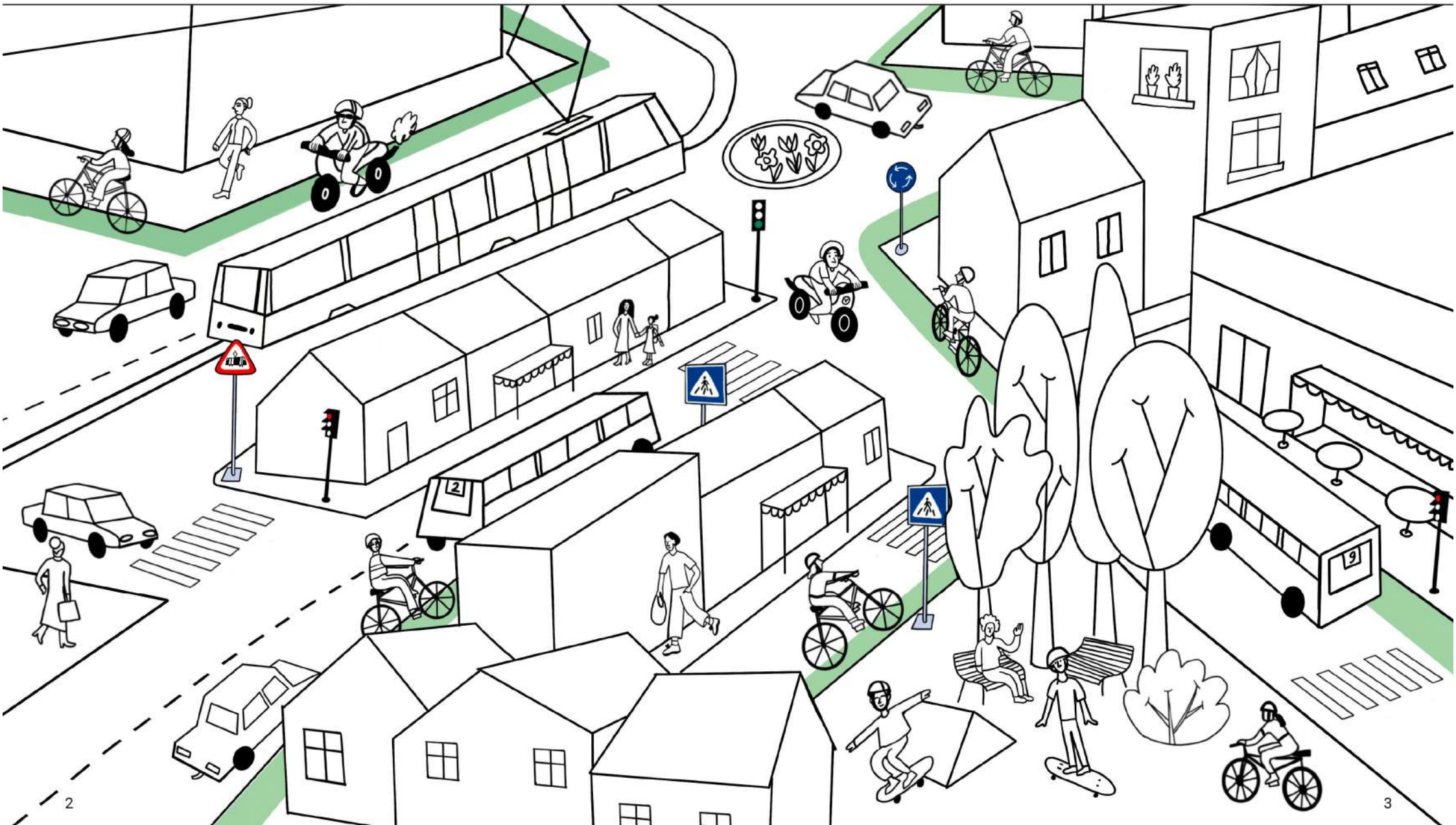
Watch out for the traffic lights and the STOP sign.

HELMET HUNT

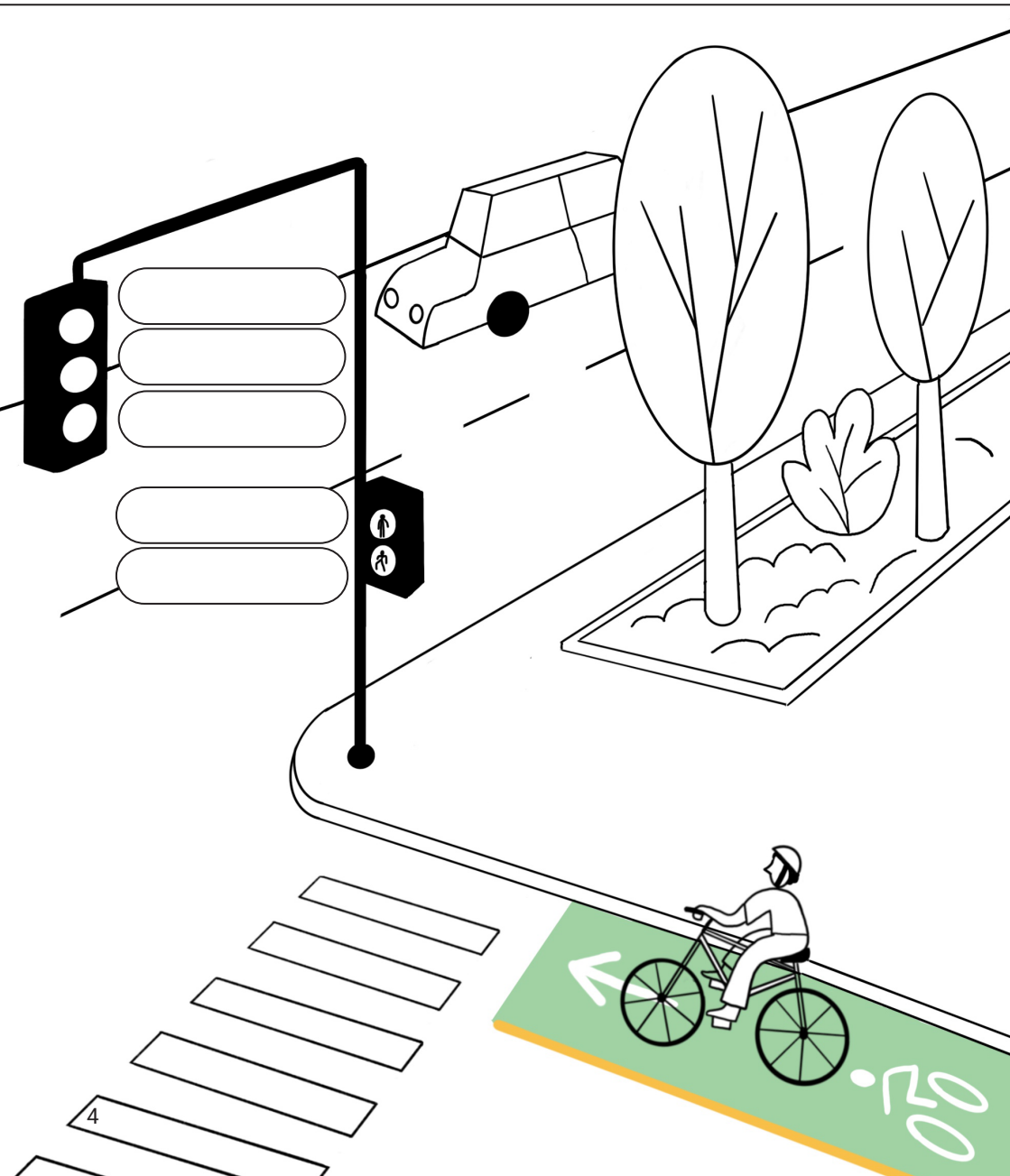
Do you know why you need a helmet and when you should wear it?

Just like brave knights once wore helmets for protection, you too should wear one when you ride your bike, scooter, or rollers. These magical helmets will keep you safe in case you stumble.









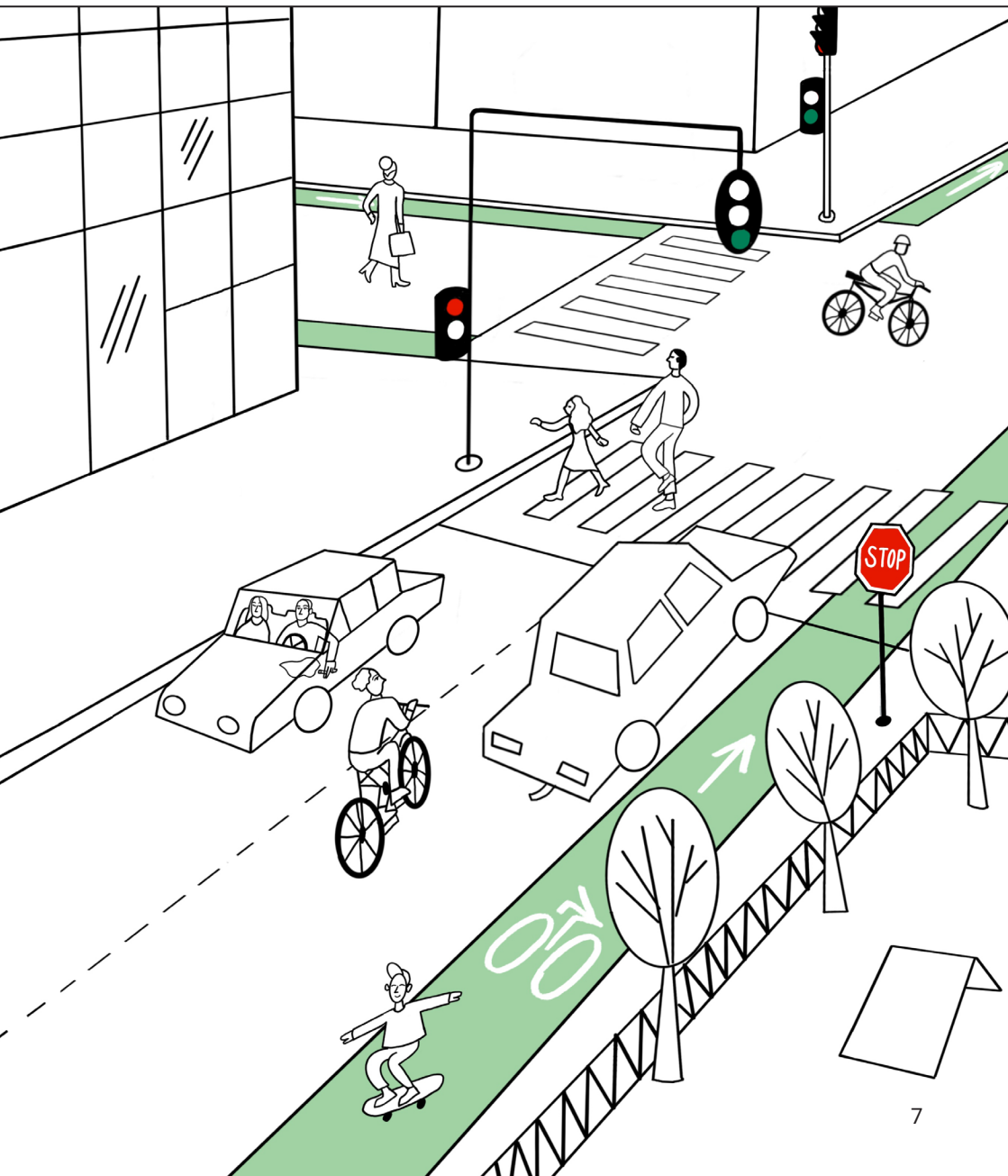
SPOT THE DIFFERENCES

Well done! You are doing great so far! Now, let's draw an X over the 7 situations or behaviors that you consider unsafe.

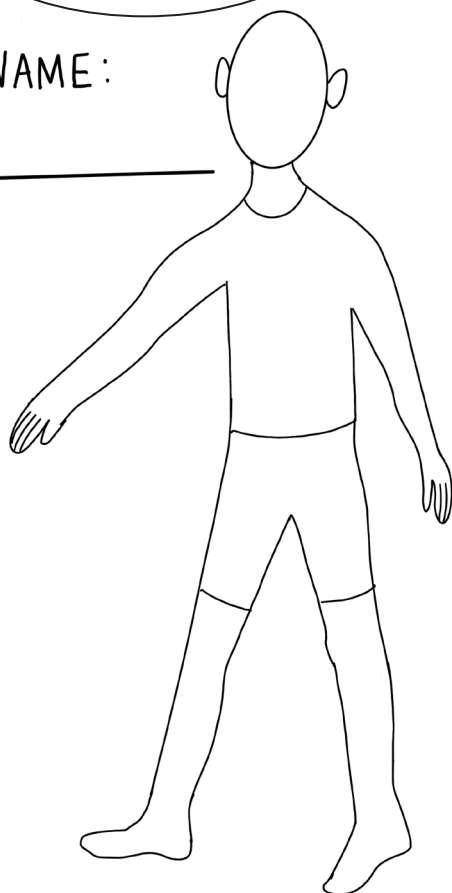


SAFETY SUPERHERO!

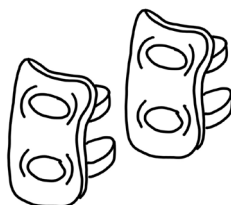
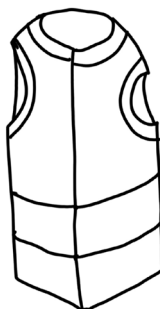
Imagine a safety superhero – somebody who makes sure traffic participants are safe. Guess what? You can be one today!

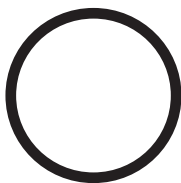

ROAD SAFETY SIGNS

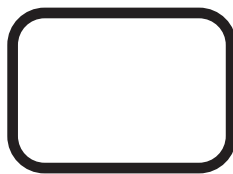
All sign shapes and colors have their own meanings – let's learn them together! Learning the signs is like learning the rules of a new game, only this one is focused on road safety.



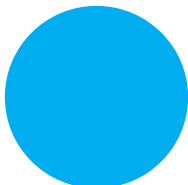
Circles
give orders



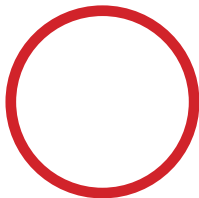
Triangles
warn



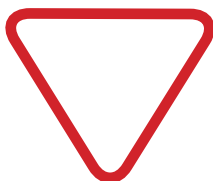
Rectangles

Look for the blue circles for directions, they will help you with instructions, such as 'turn left', or indicate a route is available only for pedestrians or specific vehicles.



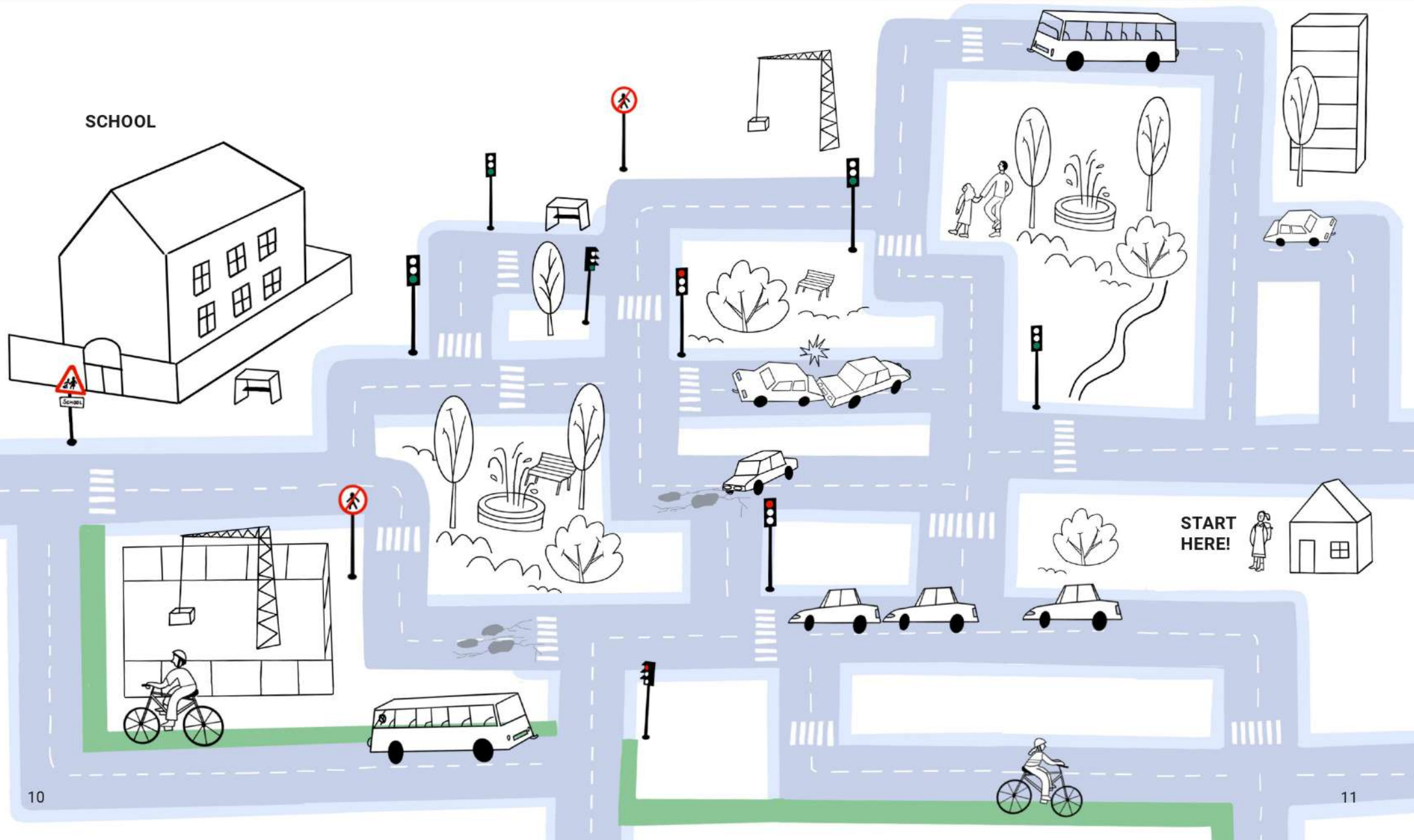
Be careful with the red rings! These will tell you what you must not do, for example, that the road is not allowed for pedestrians.



Some signs are so important that they are given different shapes to help you remember them. Examples are the "STOP" and "GIVE WAY" signs.

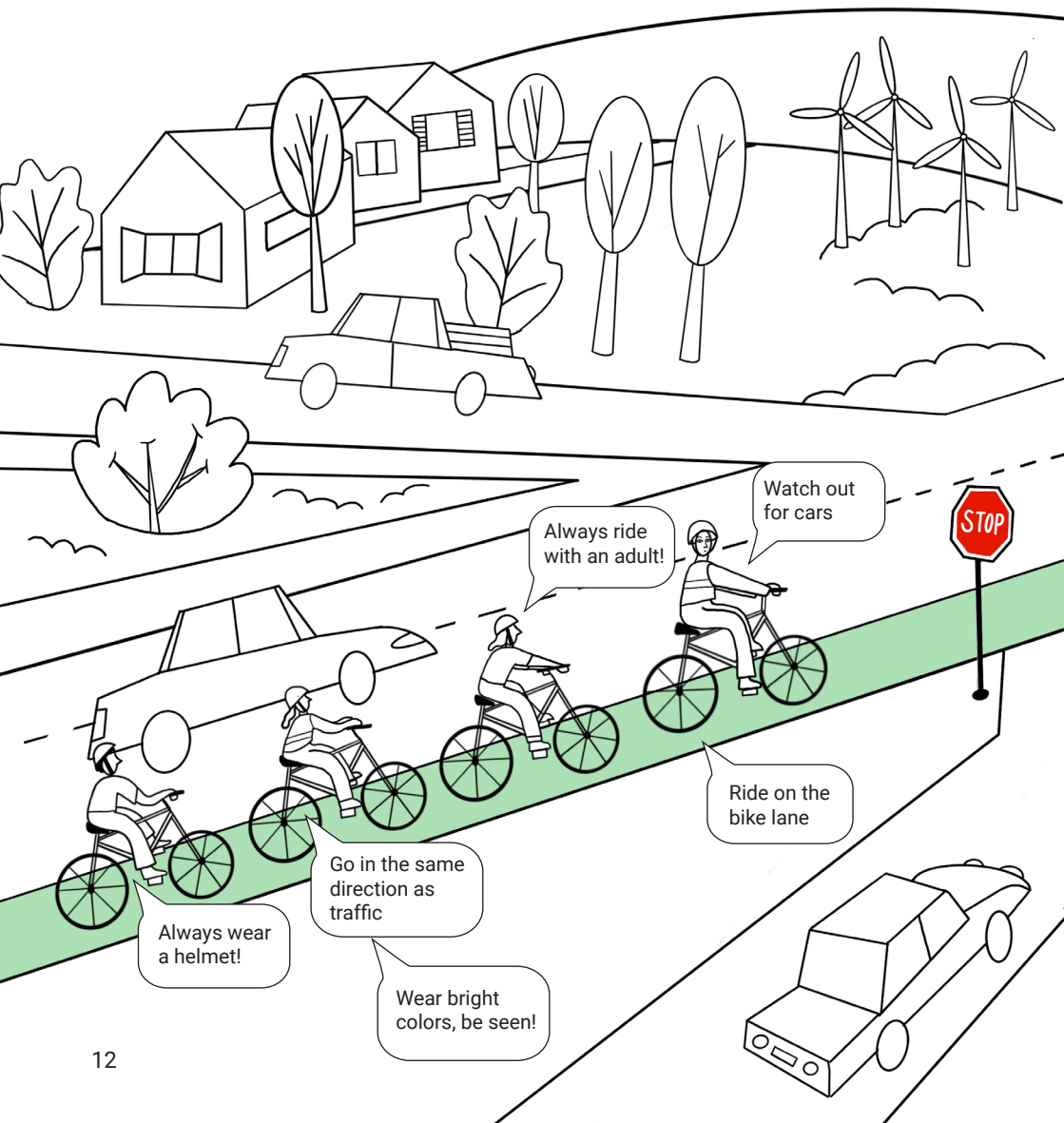
GET TO SCHOOL SAFELY

Can you find a safe way to them? Avoid road safety hazards and unsafe situations and draw your route to school.



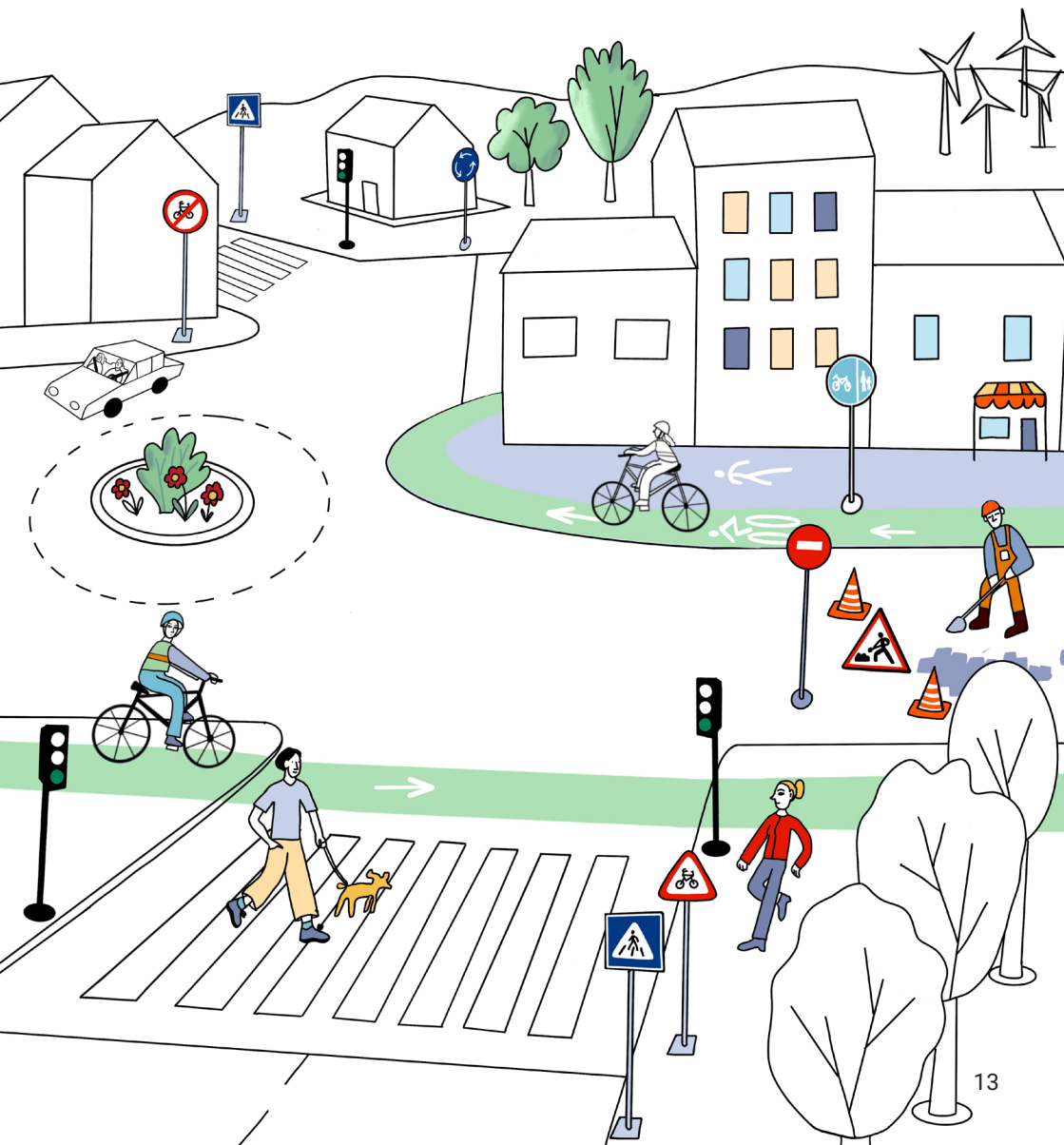
PEDALS SAFE ADVENTURES

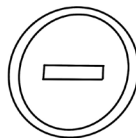

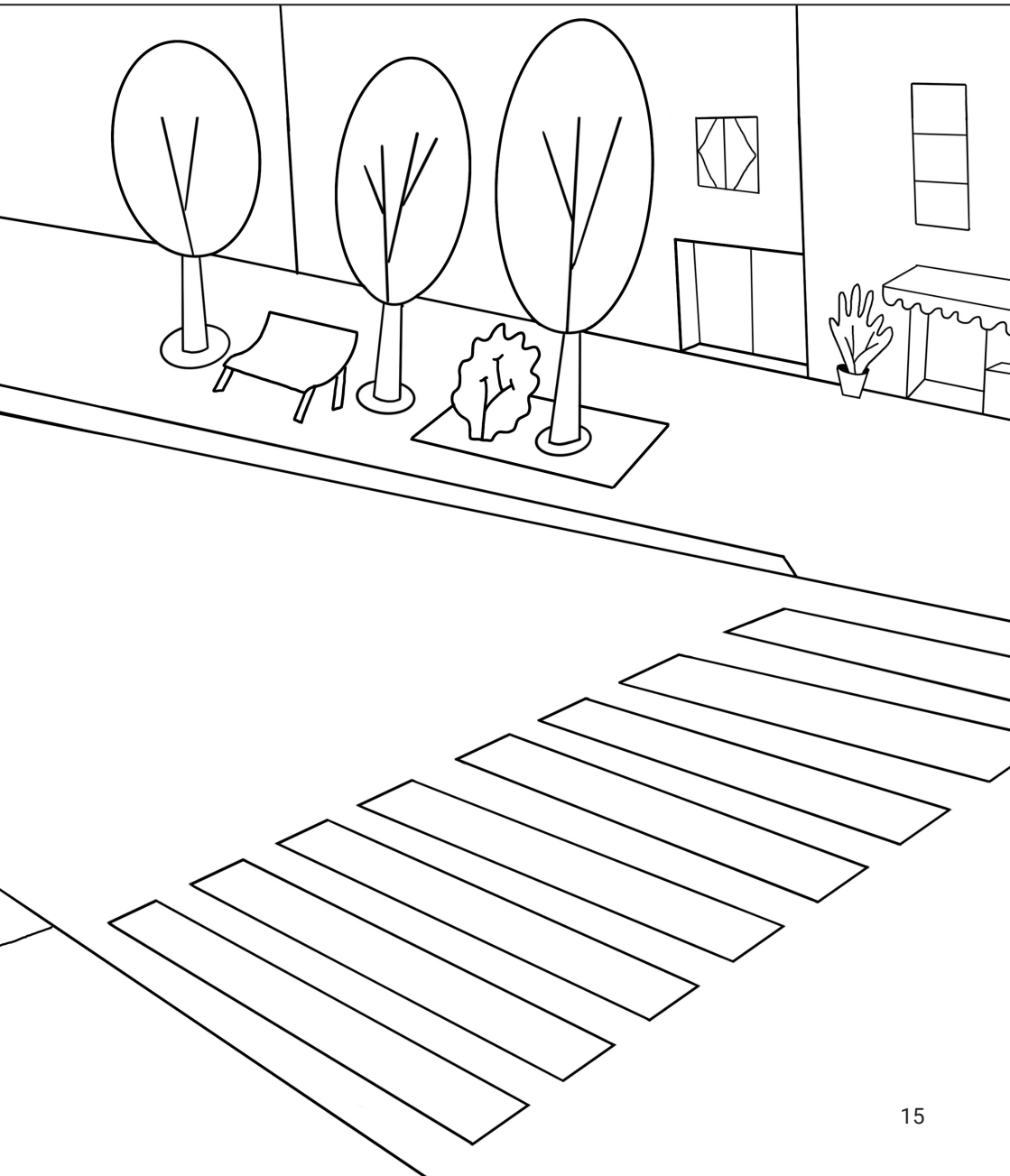

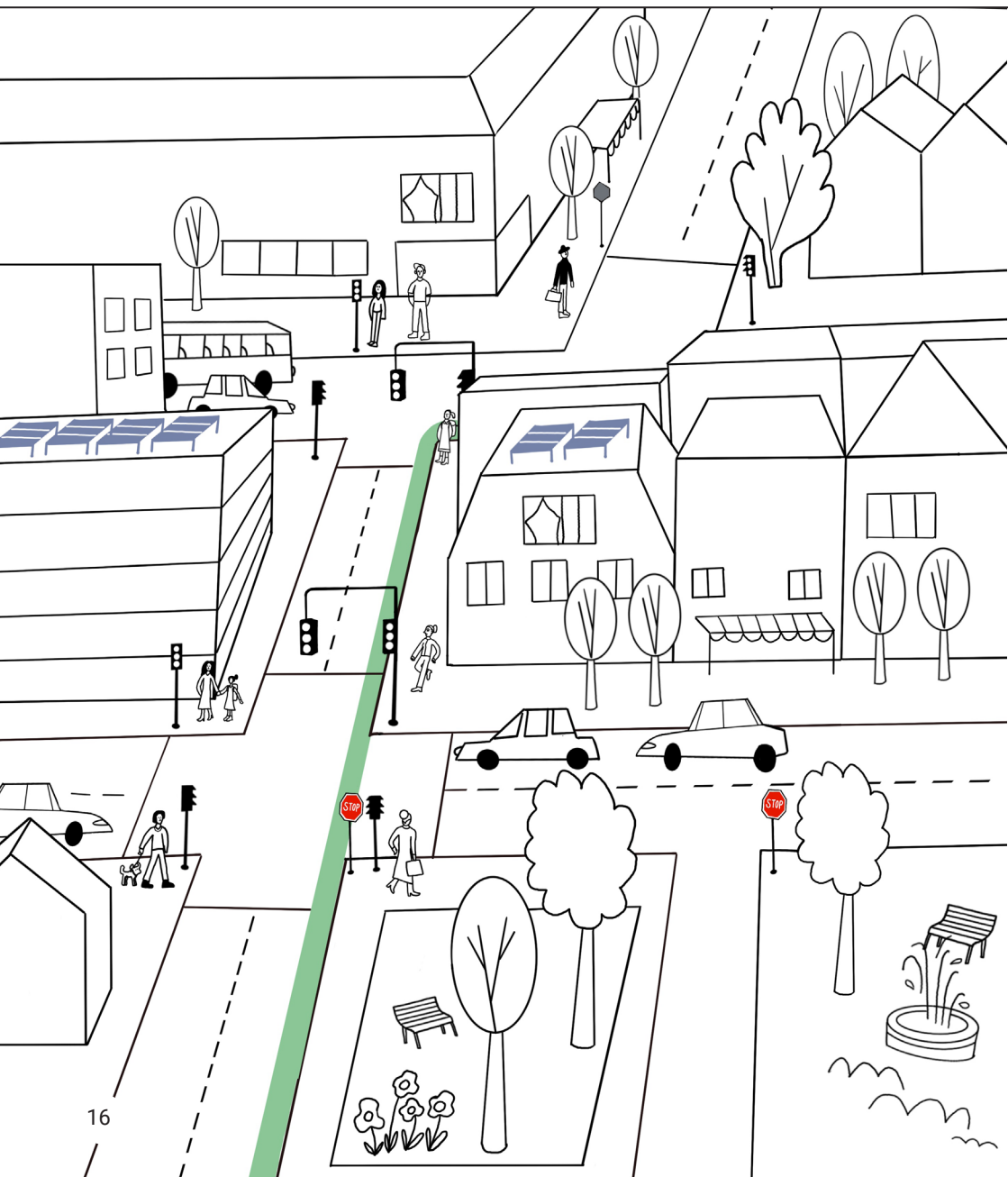
CROSSWALK DESIGNER

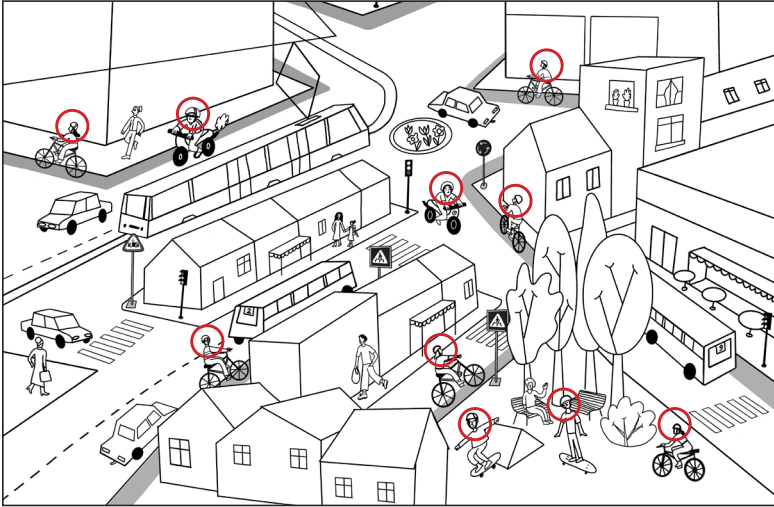

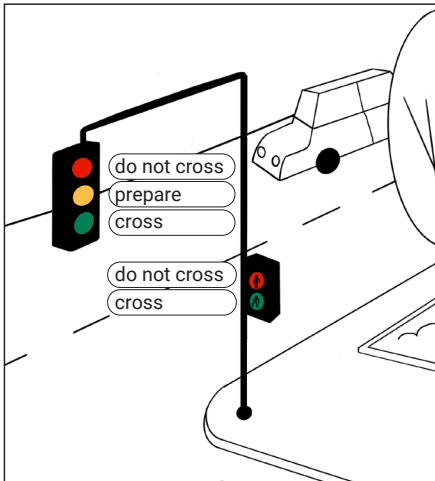
Oh, no! It looks like somebody erased the zebra crossings in the picture. Can you be our hero and draw them back where they should be, so people can cross the streets safely?



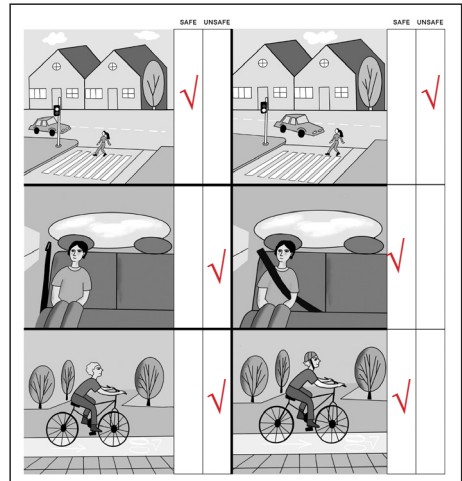
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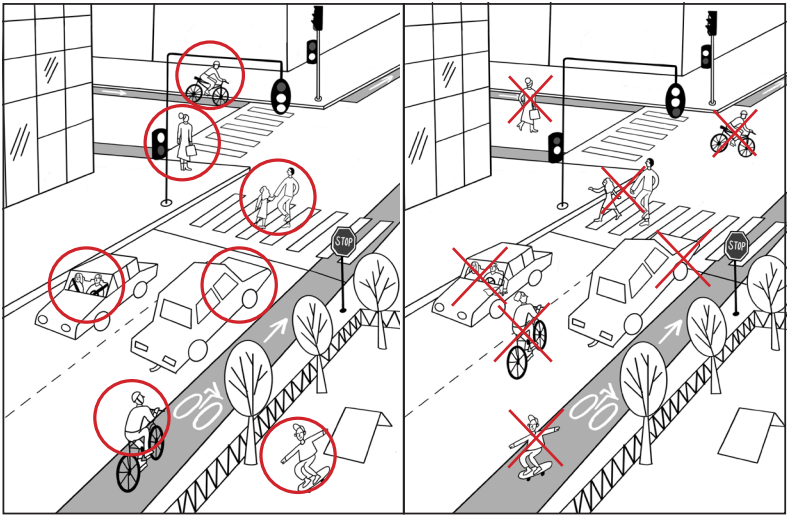
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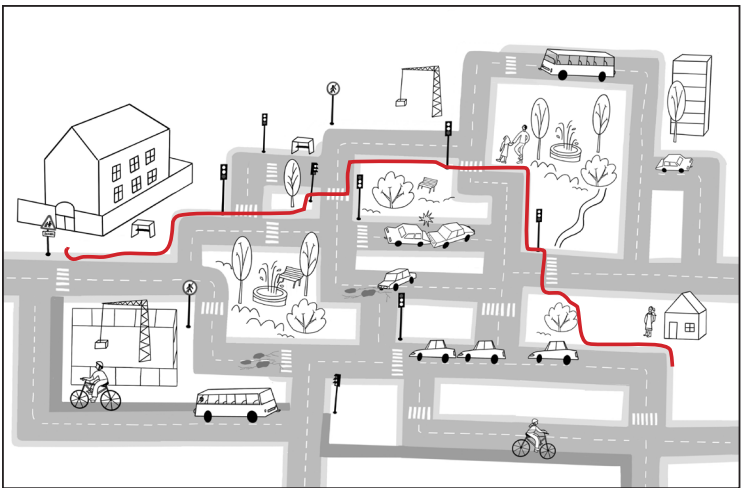
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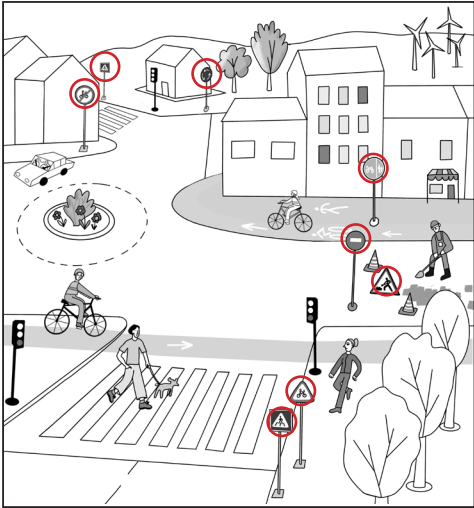
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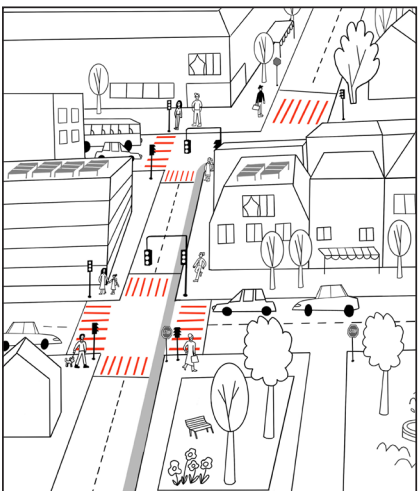
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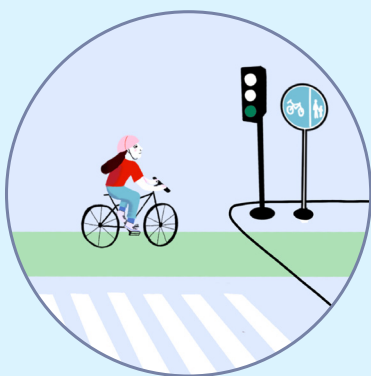
